Our faculty is a collaborative, supportive community deeply committed to the principles of Waldorf pedagogy. We offer early childhood programs through grade 7, serving a diverse and growing student body.

Role Overview

We are seeking an enthusiastic, experienced, and committed **Movement and Games Teacher** to join our faculty. In Waldorf education, movement is essential to the child's healthy physical, emotional, and social development. The ideal candidate will guide students through a developmentally appropriate curriculum that includes traditional games, Bothmer Gymnastics, Spatial Dynamics, circus arts, and team sports, fostering a sense of joy, self-confidence, collaboration, and healthy social dynamics.

Key Responsibilities

- **Curriculum Development:** Design and implement a comprehensive Movement and Games curriculum for grades 1 through 7 in alignment with Waldorf pedagogy and child development.
- **Instruction:** Lead engaging and dynamic classes that transition from cooperative and imaginative games in the lower grades to more structured sports, Bothmer Gymnastics, and Spatial Dynamics in the upper grades. Prepare and lead two classes per week, per grade or combined-grades groupings.
- **Student Assessment:** Observe, assess, and document student progress, providing regular feedback to class teachers and parents.
- **Festival Participation:** Play an active role in organizing and leading movement-based aspects of school festivals and events (e.g., the Michaelmas pageant, May Fair, and the Pentathlon).
- **Collaboration:** Work closely with class teachers to ensure the movement curriculum supports the current academic blocks and the specific needs of each class.
- **Community Engagement:** Attend weekly faculty meetings, participate in parent-teacher

conferences, and contribute to the vibrant life of the school community.

Qualifications

- **Waldorf Training:** A certificate in Waldorf Movement Education, Spatial Dynamics, or Bothmer Gymnastics is highly preferred. Candidates currently enrolled in a training program or with significant Waldorf teaching experience will also be considered.
- **Education:** A Bachelor's degree in a related field is required.
- **Experience:** Proven experience teaching movement, physical education, or sports to school-aged children, preferably in a Waldorf setting.
- **Skills:** Strong classroom management skills, a deep understanding of child development, and the ability to work collaboratively with colleagues and parents.
- **Clearances:** Must pass a Massachusetts background check, including CORI (Criminal Offender Record Information) and SORI (Sex Offender Registry Information) clearances.
- **Certifications:** Current CPR and First Aid certification (or willingness to obtain upon hire).
